- **Accessible teachers** for academic support and tech troubleshooting
- **Flexible help options** like office hours, 1:1 sessions, and concept coaching
- **Consistent communication** including platform walkthroughs and real-time progress through the family portal

The scalability of Imagine Edgenuity is also a key benefit of the program. When schools closed in March 2020 due to the pandemic, the virtual learning model was already in place. “We just had to coordinate and enroll massive amounts of students,” says McGhee. Even elementary students, who initially struggled with the transition, remained engaged, thanks to the trust and connection they had built with their virtual teachers.
